

From this intersection (Memorial and Hillsborough), travel West toward Pinellas County on Hillsborough. About 1 mile as you finish a slight curve, look on right for Publix in Colony Crossings shopping center.


On out-parcel is a Circle K and bank at intersection of Elliott Drive. Turn North onto Elliott Drive (note – there are now Speed Humps, go slow).
