Delmas gave a report on Amelia Island and reminded those interested in attending about Bob Bartel's Picnic for Alfisti on April 30.


John Picot reported on the Polo event and reminded the group of the Car Show at Celebration on April 29.

Eminent News?

Go to www.ltaliaspeed.com, and from the front page click next - look for an Alfa logo on the left, and dated April 5, 2006.

According to the story, FIAT CEO Sergio Marchionne confirms Alfa's return to the US market, and dates are not definite, but as early as late next year (indicating a late 2007 emergence).

As we've heard before, Alfa would be aligned with the Maserati network, which was separated from Ferrari earlier, rumored in preparation for the Alfa return.

Initial model lineup is said to be the Brera, 159, Spider and possibly the 8cCompetizone. Maserati CEO Karl-Heinz Kalbfell has reportedly been working with James Selwa (former Rolls Royce North America CEO) in planning the return of Alfa Romeo to US shores.

The Italian ULIM union was reported to be quick to express it's support for the return to the US market which is expected to be lucrative for the Fiat group.


