

Meeting adjourned at 8:47 PM.





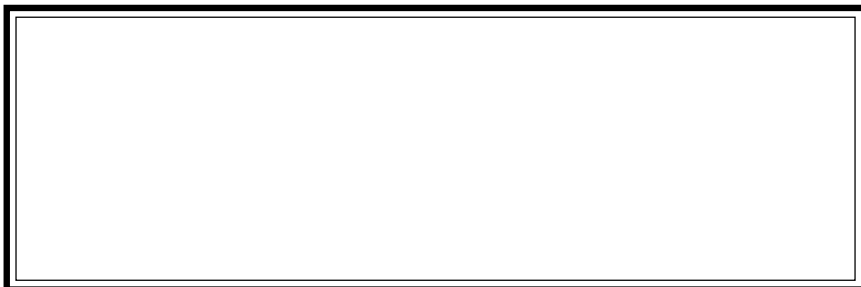
