THE GAME OF POLO

THE BASIC GAME

The game is played on a grass field measuring 300 yds by 160 yds. It is played by two teams of four riders on thoroughbreds carrying long mallets. The game is played in six periods, or chukkers, lasting seven and a half minutes. Between chukkers are intervals of four minutes for the riders to get fresh mounts. Thus it takes 48 horses to play a game. (4 horses x 2 teams x x 6 chukkers.) Between the third and fourth chukker is a 'half time' for the riders to rest and strategize and for divots to be replaced.

The object of the game is for the players to knock a ball, 3.25" in diameter and weighing 35 oz, between goal posts 8 yards apart at each end of the field. The teams change ends after each goal.

THE ADVANCED GAME

The advanced polo field has an additional ten yards of grass on both sides of the basic field where the spectators park their cars and lay out their picnics. The entire field is covered with blue sky and sunshine. The advanced game is played by merry people enjoying the weather, food, friends and watching the basic game.

The object of the advanced game is for the spectators to have a great lot of fun in the sun, sharing good food, friendship and fast, exciting action on the field. In advanced polo everyone is a winner.

CHAMPIONSHIP POLO

This sophisticated game of polo is played once a year and by people driving Alfa Romeos, Ferraris and other exotic automobiles. They arrive early at 11:00 to get the best parking places all together. They are provided with private bleachers and adjacent tent. They may bring chairs and umbrellas to stick in the ground or lash to the bleachers. At halftime some of them drive their cars around the field as their car type and driver are announced to the crowd. Others ride in a wagon
