Florida Alfa Club Tees Off at the duPont Registry 1st Annual Cars & Coffee at Innisbrook Resort

The DuPont Registry is the largest, longest published list of exclusive, expensive, exotic and sometimes even considered erotic manufactured cars available on the market. It is the collector's and foreign car owner's dream sheet.

Every month for the past twenty seven years the Registry staff of now over four dozen people in St. Petersburg, FL put together a full color, glossy magazine of about 250 pages of approximately 500 photographs listing fine autos for sale. They send out 180,000 copies a month. If you haven't seen one you're missing some sweet dreams.

On November 19th the Chairman/Publisher, Tom duPont, hosted the 1st Annual "duPont Registry Cars & Coffee" at the exclusive Innisbrook Golf Resort in Palm Harbor, Fl. His staff lined up over 500 entrants covering the manicured 17th fairway of the championship North Course and an adjacent parking lot. Included were six select cars from the Florida Alfa Club: Delmas & Polly Greene's one only 1960 2000 Vignale; Harmon & Jo Heed's blond 1964 Giulia spider "Abby", Norm & Penny Sippel's race ready 1960 Giulietta spider veloce, John & Linda Rady's award winning GTV6 Maratano, John & Cheryl Picot's sleek and slinky 1972 Montreal and Dr. Rugerro & Carla Santilli's SS Zagato.


(that means unbelievably expensive) cars of all makes and vintage. 6C2300s and 8C2900s from the Golden Age of Alfa Romeo, the 1920s and 30s. Two auctions are held. Last year over \$3,000,000,000 (that's billion with a B) worth of restored, refined automotive history was auctioned off. It is momentous to see and be on the magnificent 18th fairway of the 5 star Ritz Carlton Resort. Nearby hotel/motel rooms are almost impossible to find but our in-house concierge, Polly, has reserved rooms at a discount price. See the FAC website for details at floridaalfaclub.org.

Mar 24th, the Mid-Florida AROC is planning a rally to Bok Tower Gardens near Lake Wales in central Florida that Saturday.
