On Saturday June 29, at 3pm and 7pm, THREE world-class vocal ensembles will appear on stage at the USF Music School Concert Hall in Tampa. For fans of vocal excellence, this show is NOT to be missed. It will make American Idol/The Voice, etc., sound like caterwauling by comparison. (I am not exaggerating!)

The show will feature the current international champions of this American vocal style, ironically a hip young quartet from Sweden called Ringmasters. They are an avant garde ensemble that sings in jazz-influenced and reinterpreted pop styles too, and worth the \$25 price of admission by themselves. Excluding competitions, this is their 2nd-ever trip to the US - who knows if and when they will ever come again to Tampa Bay?

Also appearing is an international medalist quartet from the Orlando area, Main Street, who feature two former individual international champions and who sing in a very traditional style - making for a wonderful counterpoint to Ringmasters.

Finally, just added to the show (too late to make the attached poster ) is a quartet called Throwback, who in 2012 placed 6th in the world, in their first competition. Its members hail from Florida, Pennsylvania, and now England(!), and its repertoire is nearer the center of the style's continuum, between the other 2 ensembles.

This show is being sponsored by one of the choral groups I sing with, the Tampa Bay Heralds of Harmony. The Heralds will sing too, but the best reasons to see the show are the guest performers. To have one such group on a local show is certainly worth seeing (and hearing), to have two is a rare and phenomenal experience, and to have THREE world-class ensembles on one show in this area isunprecedented!
