Recent Events – FAC Drive to Boone North Carolina

For those of us who live in Florida during the hurricane season, have learned that plans are subject to change from June through October. With our planned road trip to the Greene's Farm in Boone, North Carolina this year being right in the middle of the height of the hurricane season – there was always a chance of complications.



Although our science can predict and forecast hurricanes much better than in decades past, the week preceding a hurricane can be a stressful time as we are constantly bombarded with severe weather forecasts with the storm's "Cone" of possible devastation changing daily. Initially it looked like Hurricane Irma would go up the east coast, but as time went by the cone moved progressively west, but the reality was that this storm was so large that its hurricane force winds would cover the entire width of Florida regardless of where the eye wall hit directly.

If the storm had gone up the east coast the forecasts had it hitting Savannah, or first stop on our tour up to the mountains, not a good situation but something we could have worked around. As we know, that did not happen and the storm headed right up the west coast, our worse-case scenario. The day of the storm we were looking at a CAT 4 Hurricane skirting right up the west coast of Florida staying just off shore sustaining its power with the warm waters of the Gulf of Mexico.

As our friends in Naples got hit hard, the storm suddenly slowed and went further east headed more towards the center of the state – more towards our friends in Orlando. This however meant we got only a CAT 2 storm and the eye stayed to the east of us. While I personally rode out the storm on the top floor of a condo building along the Clearwater bay, others did the right thing and bugged out and headed north away from the storm because frankly we did not know it would slow and more east. We could have endured the full force of a CAT 4 storm as was being predicted.

Stay Tuned for plans to reschedule this driving event to Boone North Carolina sometime in early May! No Hurricanes in May at least in recent Memory!

Florida Alfa Club Supports Two More Alfa Debuts

The Florida Alfa Club, with its core in the Tampa Bay area, recently supported two more dealer debuts of Alfas at the five dealerships in the club area.

The relationship began when Dayton Andrews Chrysler in Clearwater introduced the Fiat 500 in 2011 and the club lined up twelve Alfas in front of the showroom. They also displayed six Alfas in front of Suncoast Fiat in Sarasota. Then came a hiatus, waiting for the 4C in 2015, the Giulia sedan in 2016 and during those years the club cultivated the relationship with the dealers by inviting them to FAC and other car show events. Since the arrival of the 4C the club has been invited by four of the five local dealers to support the debuts of the 4C, Giulia &/or Stelvio: Brandon Alfa Romeo, Parks Alfa Romeo in Wesley Chapel, Alfa Romeo/Maserati of St Petersburg and Alfa Romeo of Winter Haven.

At every debut the club members are invited to arrive an hour early so they can dress their cars in front of the dealer's door, view and test drive the new Alfas before the crowd arrives. When the dealer's invited guests arrive they are wide eyed, contemplating the beauty of the older cars out front, usually dating from 1956 to, now, 2017. From those cars the prospective buyers get a bit of the rich Alfa history and learn about the classic cars from the club car placards and by chatting with the ardent owners.

The four, active, Florida AROC chapters are fortunate that Alfa North America has created this regional position and Lynn appointed to it.

Here are a few Florida Alfa Club's members impression of the new Stelvio.

Barry Andress – "Very quick when the gas was stepped on with very responsive steering. The gearshift would take some time to get used to, it is very sensitive and hardly moves at all."

Cheryl Picot - "Very nimble and responsive."

Delmas Greene – (He and Polly own a Giulia Lusso.) "Very similar in initial appearance to the Giulia but much taller, with a lot more ground clearance and larger tires. Same wonderful driving experience as the Giulia but I could feel a slight performance in acceleration. I could feel a little more lean in the curves, higher center of gravity would explain that. Overall impression was quite positive. Polly and I possibly should have held off purchasing a new Alfa until the Stelvio launched but then we would have missed some wonderful driving through the mountains of North Carolina this summer."

Paul Ziegler – (Owns a Giulia Ti.) "Driving a Stelvio is really close to the same as driving my Giulia Ti. If I were blind folded and put into the Stelvio I would have a difficult time telling the difference which speaks spades for the attention to detail the engineers paid in the development stage. The handling, comfort, steering and overall experience is amazingly close to the Giulia which is a great achievement

Supporting debuts has definitely fostered a symbiotic relationship between the Florida Alfa Club and local dealers. The club gets visibility at the debuts, test drives of new models, membership referrals and dealership participation at car shows. The dealers get a welcoming, colorful and historic presentation for their prospective buyers, free Alfa Owner magazines for their showrooms, invites to car show participation and buyers. FAC now has four 4Cs and three Giulia's in its corral, the newest being John Piccin's Giulia Quadrifolio. The Florida Alfa Club encourages other chapters to support their dealers and introduce them to AROC's Dealer Outreach Program advertised in *Alfa Owner*.

Mike's Sprint project is finally finished and on its way back to him. Here are a few shots of the finished car.









Car Friendly Accommodations: Beyond the Wall B&B



Shortly after Hurricane Irma I found myself on the top floor of a condo along Clearwater Bay. Although we had survived the storm, we had lost power which meant no AC, no elevators, no internet or phones. Eventually the fuel ran out for our building's generator meaning the stair wells went dark as well. Feeling for me after a few days of this, my wife Peggy, safely in Atlanta, went searching for a hotel for me to stay at until power returned.

All of the big hotels along the beach were full of people just like me, and I had second thoughts about parking my vintage car at the other places that did have vacancies. Then we found a new B&B in Dunedin called Beyond the Wall. Owned by couple consisting of a retired LT Col. (US Airforce) and a Marine Corp Sargent – Michelle and Rock. My room (the Patriot room) was large and comfortable. There was plenty of safe parking with large parking spaces for my little white 1974 vintage car. Highly Recommended if you have friends who visit with or without their vintage cars.
