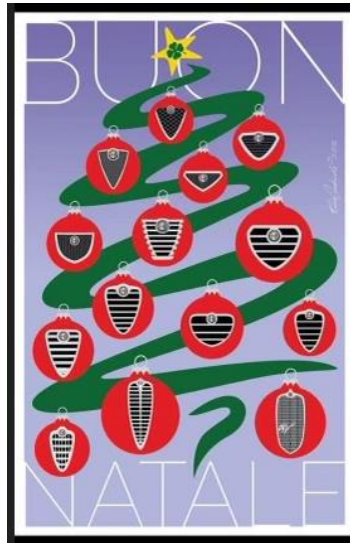


ALFETISH

The OVAROC will pay (up to 2 persons per membership) for the food/sodas/coffee/tea/desserts and each of us will pay for our drinks. Dinner will be Antipasti + Soup or Salad or Fish or Chicken or Pasta + Dessert. A nice complete Italian dinner for two people each membership (or singles). Please bring some cash (and your check books). We will have a Fundraising event to raise funds for the Club with 6 great prizes to bid on in a silent auction donated by both European Auto Specialists and Jake Sweeney Alfa Romeo and 3 great prizes to give away in a raffle. Full participation is expected and will be appreciated.
